Examination pattern

- Q1 will contain three topics. Candidates will be required to attempt one.
- Q2 will have a long passage for summarizing into one-third of its length. Candidates will be required to suggest a suitable title to the passage.
- Q3 will be stimulus based question, ie, the question paper will provide written stimulus for developing into an appropriate advertisement. There will be internal/parallel choice in the question.
- Q4 will have three parts: (a) will have 5 short simple sentences to be marked for stress and intonation; (b) will have 10 prefixes and/or suffixes to be added to root words in order to make meaningful words. (c) will contain 5 idioms/phrases to be used in meaningful sentences.
- Q5 will have a passage in Urdu/Hindi to be translated into English. Word for word translation will not be accepted.
